(Completed 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, or 9<sup>th</sup> grade)  
1st Prize \$250 and an invitation to perform

(Completed 6<sup>th</sup> grade or lower)  
1st Prize \$100 and Trophy
