

Floot Forward is a new program by Floot Fire Inc. to help get instruments into the hands of disadvantaged schools and students.

Who can receive donated flutes?

- Only schools may apply.
- Beneficiaries are chosen by need based merit.
- Applicants may receive a limit of 1 donated instrument per year.
- Instruments become the property of the school. All repairs are at owner's expense.

How can my school get donated instruments?

- All schools interested in purchasing a low cost instrument must apply online.
- Criteria guidelines for school applicants are:
 - o Must have an established instrumental music program in place.
 - Must have an instrumental music teacher employed at the school.
 - o Must have the ability to property implement, care for and store the instrument.
 - o Must be within 75 miles of one of our Floot Fire workshops.

How are beneficiaries selected?

- A committee oversees the selection process.
- Instruments will be donated as supplies last.
- Schools who meet or exceed the criteria above will be given instruments on a first come-first served basis.
- Individuals who meet or exceed the criteria above will be receive instruments on a first come-first served basis.
